Step 1 Accept your offer

After you've done your happy dance, go to **GeorgianCollege.ca/congrats** to accept your offer of admission.



Step 2 Pay your fees and plan your budget

To secure your seat in the program, pay your \$500 non-refundable tuition deposit. After that, your full tuition fees are due at the start of each term.

What if my offer is conditional?

You can still accept your offer! Before you can start your program, you'll need to meet requirements, complete courses or upgrading, or send in documents. For example, high school students need to complete their last few classes, and mature applicants may need to complete testing requirements. To see what you need to do, go to your academic dashboard.

HOW DO I ACCESS MY ACADEMIC DASHBOARD?

- Go to **GeorgianCollege.ca/congrats** and click on *View academic dashboard*.
- Log in with your Georgian student email address; your password is your date of birth (YYMMDD).
- Click on *Academics* and then *Academic Dashboard*.

You can afford this!

Postsecondary education is an investment in your future. There are many ways we can help you make ends meet.

WHEN DO I PAY MY \$500 NON-REFUNDABLE TUITION DEPOSIT?

- September 2019 start: June 17
- January 2020 start: Oct. 3
- May 2020 start: Feb. 17

HOW MUCH IS TUITION?

Your full fees are due on day 11 of each term. For a full list of fees by program, visit **GeorgianCollege.ca/feeschedule**.

HOW DO I PAY?

You can pay through your banking app or online banking. Your account number is your nine-digit student number and the payee is GeorgianCollegeTuition.





Step 3 Register for courses

Each student has a specific date and time to register for courses, about a month before classes. Once you've paid your deposit, you can find your registration window at GeorgianCollege.ca/banner

How does registration work?

- Registration opens about one month before classes begin. Your specific registration day and time can be found at GeorgianCollege.ca/banner about two months before the term starts.
- After you register for courses in Banner, check out your timetable and book list.
- About a week after you get your timetable, you can add or drop courses.

HOW DO I GET COURSE EXEMPTIONS?

If you have relevant postsecondary experience, our Transfer Equivalency tool can help you explore course exemptions or advanced standing. If you have relevant work or life experience, you can do a prior learning assessment to see if you're eligible for exemptions.

WHAT ARE MY HOUSING OPTIONS?

To get into an on-campus residence in Barrie, Orillia or Owen Sound, apply at GeorgianCollege.ca/housing by early April. To search rental properties at all campuses, go to places4students.com. Georgian doesn't inspect listings, so thoroughly research your options.

DO I NEED A CAR?

All seven campuses are in communities offering local public transit, and bus or train service to Toronto. For Barrie students, your Barrie Transit U-Pass is included in your fees. Students can also pay for parking.

WHAT ABOUT MEAL PLANS?

Barrie, Orillia and Owen Sound campuses have several food providers. Students can use their ONEcards to buy food as well as course materials. ONEcards can be pre-loaded online.

WHAT ARE MY FITNESS OPTIONS?

Barrie, Orillia and Owen Sound campuses offer state-of-the-art fitness centres (membership is included in your fees), fun intramural sports, friendly tournaments, and of course competitive varsity teams. Go Grizzlies!
